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

#### **OPEC BACK THEN**

- OPEC's influence began to emerge in 1970s
- National oil companies were formed (Sonangol, PDVSA, NNPC)
- US production began to decline at that time
- OPEC first started to influence the world's supply of oil, and in turn its price.




### **QUOTAS, OUTPUT CEILINGS**

- First began setting quotas in 1982
- OPEC collectively agreed a production target
- In 2008, OPEC agreed to reduce output three times in the space of three months




### **CHANGE IN OPEC STRATEGY**

- Jan 2012: Output ceiling of 30 million b/d
- Nov 2014: Maintained output ceiling
- Removed quotas in Nov 2014
- Market share strategy
- Emergence of US shale




### **OPEC OUTPUT**

#### **OPEC** output (million b/d)





#### **SAUDI-IRAN FEUD**


#### Saudi Arabia production (million b/d)








## Iranian oil output post-sanctions production (million b/d)


