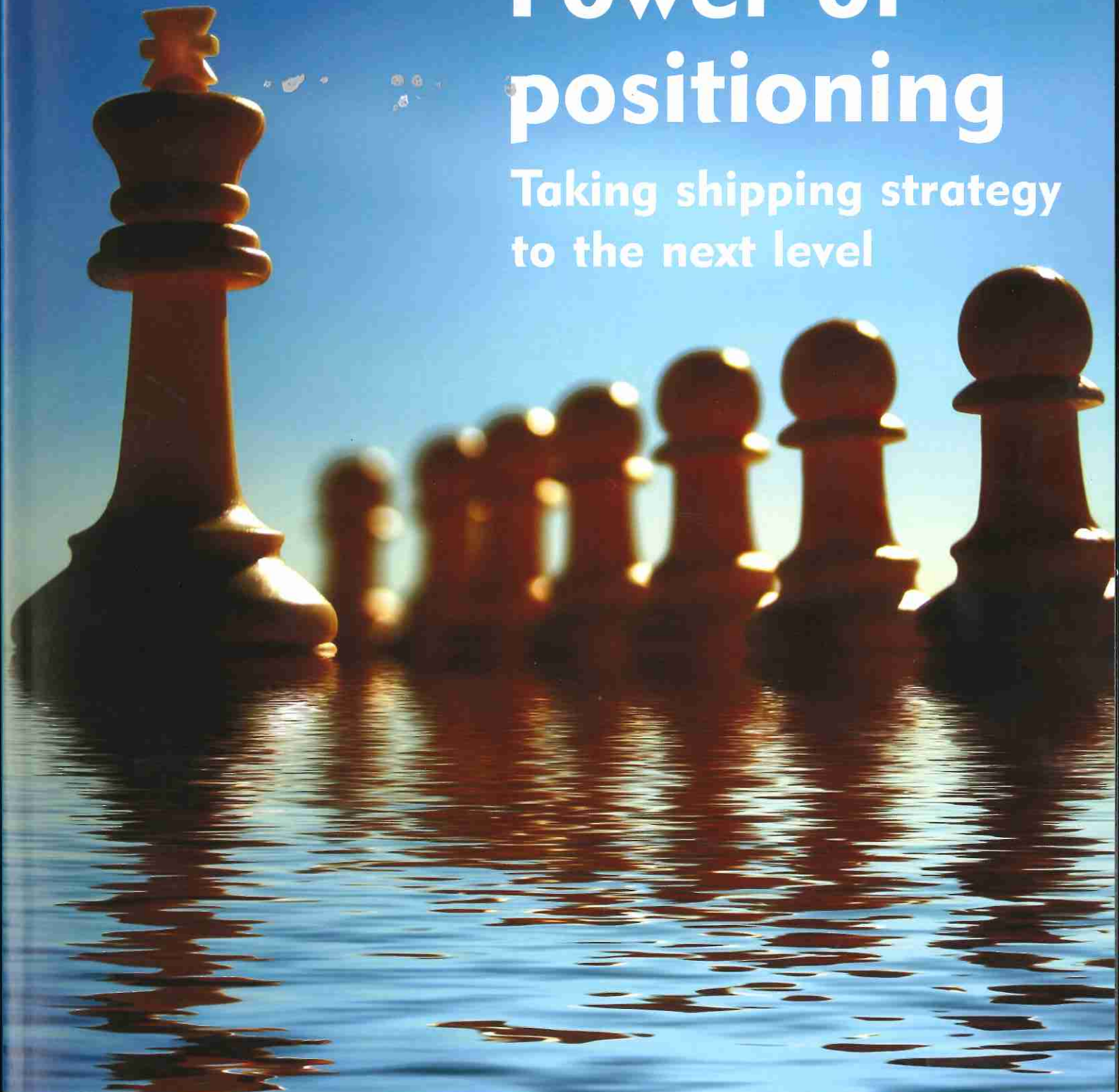

The Mission to Seafarers' Revd Andrew Wright was the evening's guest of honour



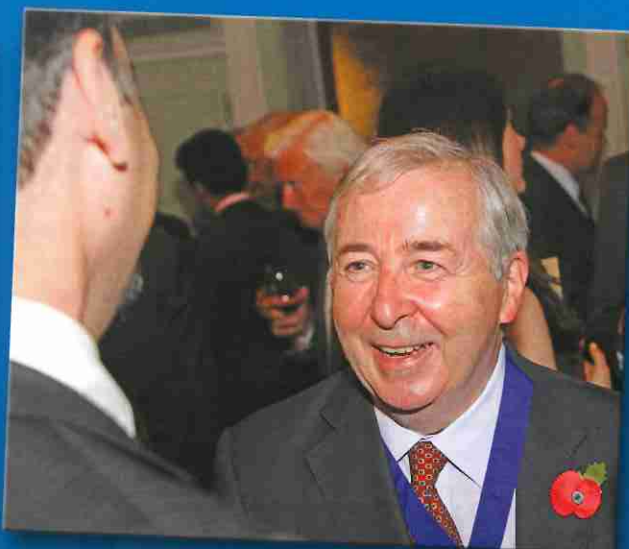

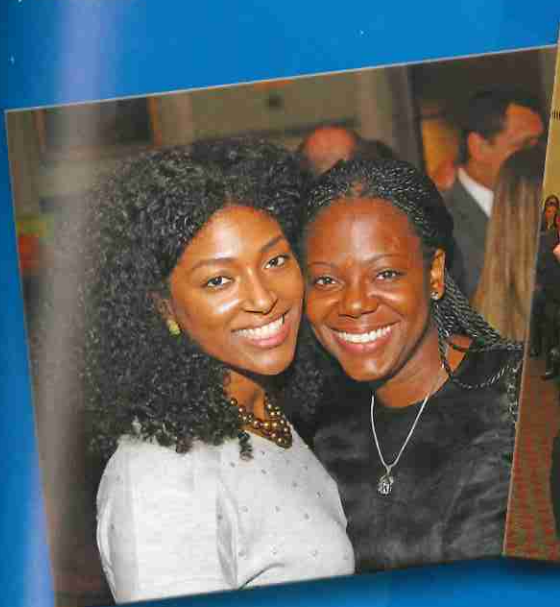
